ENSPY VISIT REPORT

Preparatory visit to the ENSPY administration — 2 September 2026

1. Background

On 2 September 2026, between 1:00 PM and 3:40 PM, a delegation from the ASPY Alumni Association visited ENSPY to establish first contact with the school's administration and to lay the groundwork for setting up an office space for the Association within the institution. During the visit, the delegation met with several school officials, presented the Association together with its ongoing projects and master plan, and gathered valuable feedback and guidance to inform the next steps.

Overall, the visit proved encouraging: the delegation was met with a particularly positive reception from Mme Bissene, Dr Mbinkar and Professor Mbouetou, whose enthusiasm and openness spoke well for the Association's continued engagement with ENSPY.

2. Officials Met

1. Mme Mariette Bissene — *Coordinator, Technipole Center (Project Incubator)*

Received the delegation warmly following a brief presentation of ASPY, its ongoing projects and its master plan.

Indicated that all office spaces under her management were currently occupied but rather committed to making every effort to free up some offices and to get back to the delegation within the coming month.

2. Mme Boyomo — *Deputy Director, ENSPY*

Due to a tight schedule, was only able to grant the delegation a brief exchange. She invited the delegation to return the following Wednesday for a more substantive discussion.

3. Prof. Paul Salomon Ngohe Ekam — *Former HOD Genie Électrique*

Was greeted by the delegation; owing to limited time, was unable to fully take in the presentation of the project.

The delegation informed him that they would return to greet him again in the near future. He also informed us that he had retired but still offered some courses part time.

4. Prof. Mbouetou — *Head of Department, Génie Informatique*

A rich and substantive exchange took place, during which he expressed genuine enthusiasm for the Association.

Shared, by way of reference, an overview of the notable achievements of the Polytech Paris alumni network.

During the exchange, we presented the ASPY alumni website and encouraged the Association to pursue international funding and larger-scale projects.

Recalled the efforts of former Director AWONO, who had fought hard on behalf of anglophone students at ENSPY, and suggested that a gesture of appreciation toward him would be fitting.

He was highly receptive to the idea of an ASPY convention and expressed his willingness to attend.

5. Dr Mbinkar — *Head, Hitech Center; Faculty, Génie Électrique*

A brief exchange occurred between Dr MBINKAR and the delegation. He advised the Association to formally apply for an office space after identifying a suitable office.

He also informed us that he would reach out directly to the delegation should he identify an available space.

3. Audience Requested with the Director of ENSPY

A request for an audience with the Director of ENSPY was also submitted. His secretariat indicated that a meeting would be scheduled for the following week in case he gave a favorable outcome to our request.

4. Recommendations following the visit

- Follow up with Mme Boyomo (Deputy Director) the following Wednesday 09 September 2026, as invited.
- Await feedback from Mme Bissene (Technipole Center) and Dr Mbinkar (Hitech Center) regarding available office space.
- Await confirmation of the audience with the Director from his secretariat.
- Consider a gesture of appreciation toward former Director AWONO who considerably improved the conditions of studies for Anglophones students of ENSPY, as suggested by Prof. Mbouetou.
- Begin preparations for the ASPY convention, building on the very positive reception given to this idea by Prof. Mbouetou.

5. Conclusion

This initial contact with the ENSPY administration marks an encouraging step in the process of establishing the Alumni Association within the institution. The overwhelmingly positive reception received, particularly from Mme Bissene, Dr Mbinkar and Professor Mbouetou, reflects genuine openness on the part of the school toward the initiative and points to promising prospects for the steps ahead.

At the end of the tour the ASPY President joined the delegation as she was constrained by her internship.
